HM Queen Victoria: A Lock of Hair in an elaborate oval crowned silver gilt easel frame, engraved verso *The hair of Her Majesty Queen Victoria graciously given to me by Her Majesty, March 1842, Elizabeth Waymouth*

- 4 invitations to the marriage of HRH Princess Helena, 5th July 1866 and (2) to the luncheon following, to the marriage of HRH Princess Louise, July 27th 1871 and to The Chapel of St George, Windsor Castle, 21st March 1871.
- A hymnsheet on the occasion of the Queen's visit to Leeds on September 7th 1858. Two souvenirs with faux lace borders of the marriage of HRH Princess Helena.
- A programme for an entertainment at Osborne April 14, 1866: Phantasmagoria and Dissolving Views by Carpenter and Westley. A printed hymn by the Bishop of Wakefield for the Jubilee, 20 June 1897.
- Programme for a service of Thanksgiving at the Chapel Royal, St. James' Palace, for the long life of Her Majesty the Queen May 24th 1899.
