On January 23, 2008 through March 26, 2008, the Los Angeles Police Department will be conducting the Korean Community Police Academy.

The ten-week course will be held at the Korean Education Center located at 680 Wilshire Place, Los Angeles, 90005. The class will meet each Wednesday evening between 6:30 p.m. and 9:30 p.m. The course will conclude with a graduation ceremony on April 2, 2008.

Through the Community Police Academy, enrolled students will be encouraged to build a lasting partnership with the Department, with the ultimate goal of reducing crime and improving the quality of life in our neighborhoods.

Each community member must meet the following criteria:

- Must be 18 years or older;
- Live or work within Operations-Central Bureau or Operations-West Bureau;
- No prior felony convictions;
- No outstanding warrants;
- No pending criminal cases; and
- Must be approved by an Area Commanding Officer.
