**1. BOARD ACTION ON PERMITS PURSUANT TO LAMC 103.29**

On a motion by Ara Bedrosian, seconded by Rickey Gelb, the Panel, by unanimous vote, APPROVED the Commission Investigation Division calendars of June 28, 2006, July 5, 2006, July 12, 2006, and July 19, 2006.
