**1. APPROVAL OF MINUTES – MAY 16, 2007**

On a motion by Ara Bedrosian, seconded by Victor Narro, the Panel, by a unanimous vote, APPROVED the minutes of May 16, 2007.

**2. BOARD ACTION ON PERMITS PURSUANT TO LAMC 103.29**

On a motion by Rickey M. Gelb, seconded by Victor Narro, the Panel, by a unanimous vote, APPROVED the Commission Investigation Division calendar of June 6, 2007.

**3. BOARD ACTION ON APPLICATIONS FOR BUSINESS TAX  
EXEMPTION PURSUANT TO LAMC 21.22**

On a motion by Victor Narro, seconded by Ara Bedrosian, the Panel, by a unanimous vote, APPROVED the following applicant for Business Tax Exemption:
