Hello Topanga Area! Canoga Park, West Hills, Woodland Hills, and Winnetka,

Now that Topanga has been operational for a full nine months, here are some numbers that are a clear indication of just how hard the men and women of Topanga are working for you. There have been a jaw dropping **32,116** "Calls for Service" placed! Officers have issued **7,614** moving citations and made **1,558** felony arrests. These are outstanding numbers and we should applaud the dedication of our officers... Thank you Topanga Area Police Station!!

property. The three juveniles were subsequently arrested and the property was returned to the owners. This is just one example of the excellent investigative and crime solving work Topanga Detectives are doing!



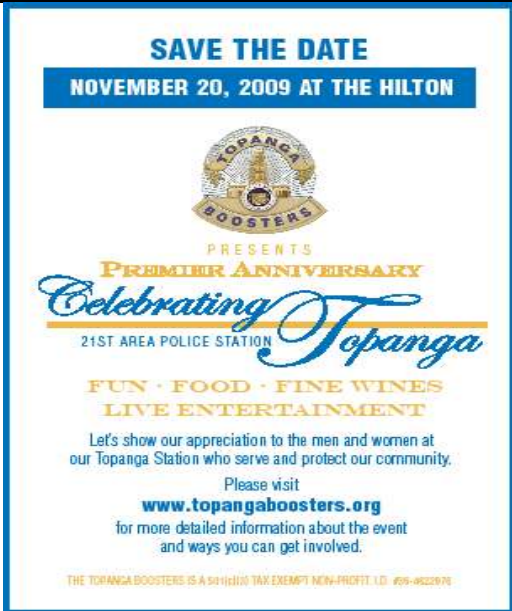
Halloween Safety Tips

DID YOU KNOW...

The Office of Community Beautification, Board of Public Works, has created a “self-help” website for residents requesting graffiti removal. The website is

www.anti-graffiti.lacity.org. This website will assist in the removal of graffiti from public property and private property (with owner consent). The graffiti must be visible from the public right-of-way in order to use this service. Structures NOT included in this service include schools (maintained by LAUSD), freeways (maintained by CalTrans), billboards (maintained by owner), and parks (maintained by Recreation & Parks). Recent news in my area:

On September 2, 2009, Officers Mireles and Figuerch responded to a “Grand Theft Auto” call that just occurred at Fallbrook Avenue and Sherman Way. The victim (an 85 year-old WWII veteran), whose vehicle was equipped with Lojack, was activated by our Topanga PSR. Officers were able to locate the vehicle in the area of Lurline Avenue and Sherman Way. Topanga Crime Suppression Units then watched the vehicle until it started moving, at which point, Topanga Patrol Units stopped the vehicle and arrested three individuals. One male suspect was arrested for carjacking, a female suspect for grand theft auto, and a third male suspect for harboring a fugitive. This is an excellent example of our different units working together to make a great arrest!

On September 13, 2009, a homicide occurred around the 20000 block of Saticoy Street at a bar. Subsequently, a CPA gang member was arrested for that murder.

There is no direct crime pattern in 21A29’s area however, several people have been burglarized. Suspects are gaining entry into the residences due to windows being left open and/or unlocked. **PLEASE** make sure to properly secure your homes and cars at all times!

On September 17, 2009, at 1630 hours Officers Rios and Rodriguez observed a residential burglar as he left a home at the 21800 block of Strathern Street. After a foot chase and a K-9 dog search, the suspect was arrested for burglary. Outstanding team work!
