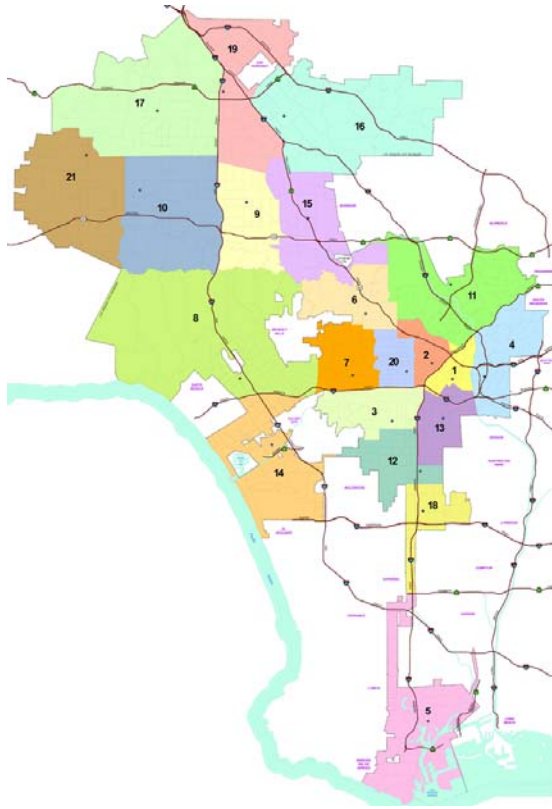

THE ORIGINS OF C-PABs

Community Police Advisory Boards (C-PABs) were created in 1993 to advise and inform the Los Angeles Police Departments Area Commanding Officers of quality-of-life problems and concerns in the community. Members of C-PAB represent the diversity of the community, including residents, businesses, neighborhood councils, social services, religious organizations and a multitude of agencies, departments and City Council representatives. The C-PABs meet monthly with their Commanding Officer, Senior Lead Officers and other City representatives to share information and develop problem-solving strategies.

C-PAB GOALS

The C-PABs serve as advisory and problem-solving groups predicated on a community government philosophy. As a conduit for communities to address their concerns, C-PABs consist of subcommittees which have been developed to respond to specific community issues. Committee participants may include various City agencies and departments. Among those are LAPD, DOT, LAFD, Bureau of Street Services, Department of Building and Safety and the Bureau of Public Works. In addition, City Council members and their staffs are a vital component of the C-PAB philosophy.

C-PAB SUBCOMMITTEES:

SENIOR & FAMILY VIOLENCE:

A partnership between community and government agencies. The Senior & Family Violence subcommittee supports prevention, intervention and prosecution efforts focused on domestic violence, partner abuse, child abuse and elder abuse/neglect.

GRAFFITI: Graffiti Committees work to address the problem of graffiti in all areas of the City. This committee works closely with the appropriate City agencies and outside resources to eliminate graffiti from our neighborhoods.

TRAFFIC: Traffic Committees help to improve communication between the community and the City's agencies in addressing traffic-related issues. This collaboration assists the appropriate government agencies in responding to residents and businesses, making them more responsive and accountable to the community.

YOUTH: With the assistance of various youth organizations such as the YMCA, YWCA, Police Activities League and Boys & Girls Clubs, Youth Committees seek to connect our young adults to their community and to give them a voice to make positive changes in their lives and in their neighborhoods.

GETTING INVOLVED

For the past 15 years, C-PAB members from throughout Los Angeles have gathered together for the Annual C-PAB Summit. The purpose of the annual event is to bring C-PAB members together with LAPD personnel to share experiences, practices and success stories. The Annual C-PAB Summits have been held in a variety of unique locations, including the Los Angeles Convention Center, the Wilshire Ebell Theatre and the Getty Center. As a C-PAB member, you will have the opportunity to be a part of this annual event.

Community involvement and resources are an important factor in the success of C-PABs. We encourage interaction between community members and the multitude of agencies and departments within the City of Los Angeles. These partnerships, which C-PABs have fostered, have enabled communities to face and overcome the challenges of various quality-of-life issues.
