TOPANGA POLICE YOUTH BOARD

TOPANGA AREA CADET POST #2100

The Topanga Area Cadet Post is a program that provides special training to young people that are interested in a law enforcement career and assists them in becoming better citizens in their community, while developing a positive relationship between themselves and the police.

Cadet recruits will receive Recruit Cadet Academy training that includes various law enforcement topics and the *Character Counts* curriculum, which is designed to build leadership skills and instill character through ethical decision making. Also incorporated in the training is a version of *Toastmasters*, which teaches improved communication skills and self-confidence through the art of public speaking.

POLICE ACTIVITY LEAGUE

The Police Activity League (PAL) is a youth crime prevention program that relies on educational, athletic and other recreational activities to form a bond between police officers and the youth in your community. The PAL program gives disadvantaged youth (ages 6 to 17) the opportunity to participate in activities by partnering with the Boys and Girls club. The activities are supervised by a police officer and are invaluable to the young impressionable minds of the participants.

JEOPARDY

The Jeopardy program is a gang prevention program to deter juveniles from the negativity associated with gangs and to promote family support. The program seeks to serve families with children between 9 to 17 years of age who are at risk of being recruited or lured into the gang lifestyle.

A formal intake process guarantees that the program is focused on at-risk youth and a six month program provides for a period of support, resources and effectiveness to turn these youth in the right direction. Some of the goals are to improve grades, decrease truancy, improve self-esteem and decrease the risk of gang involvement.
