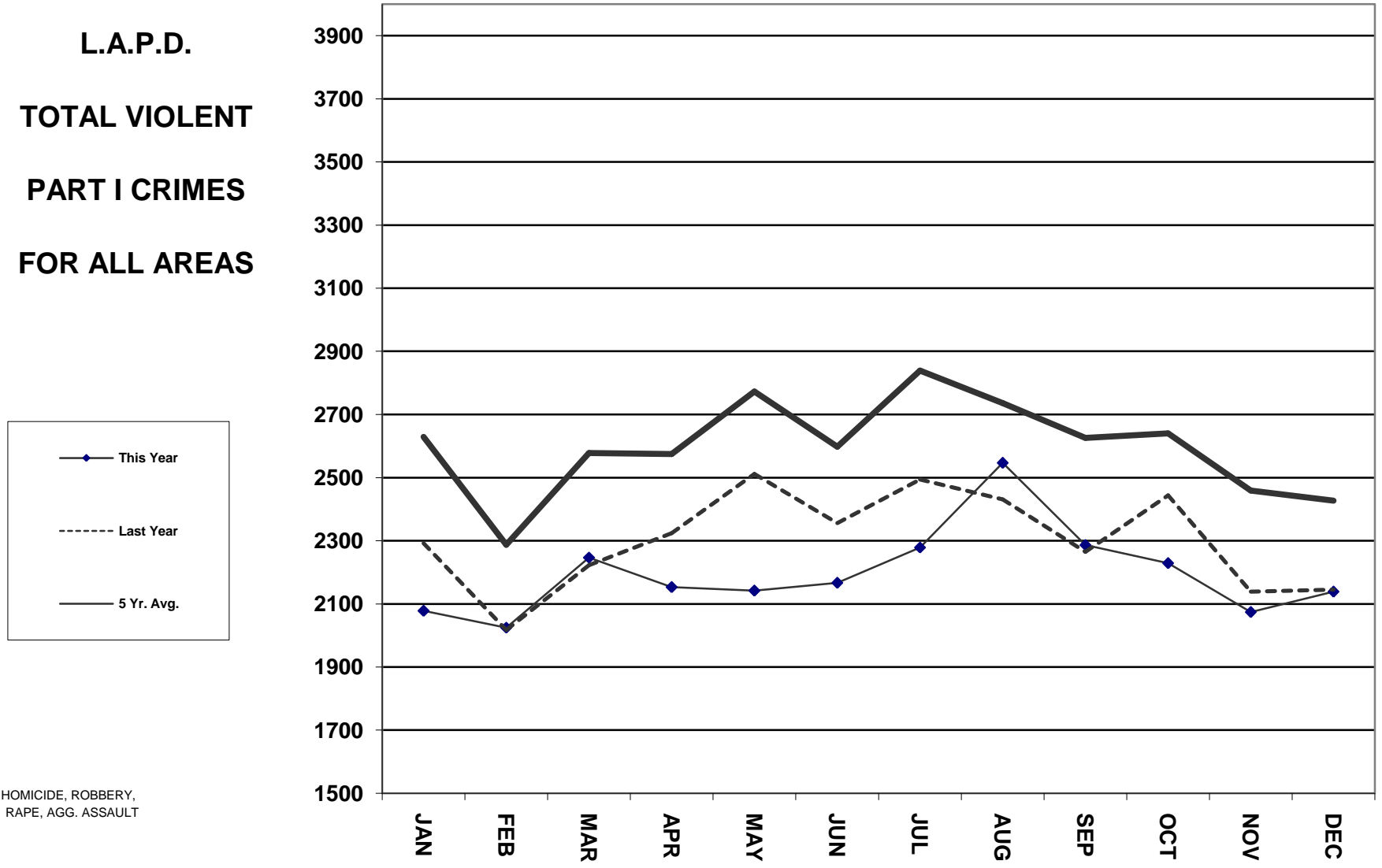

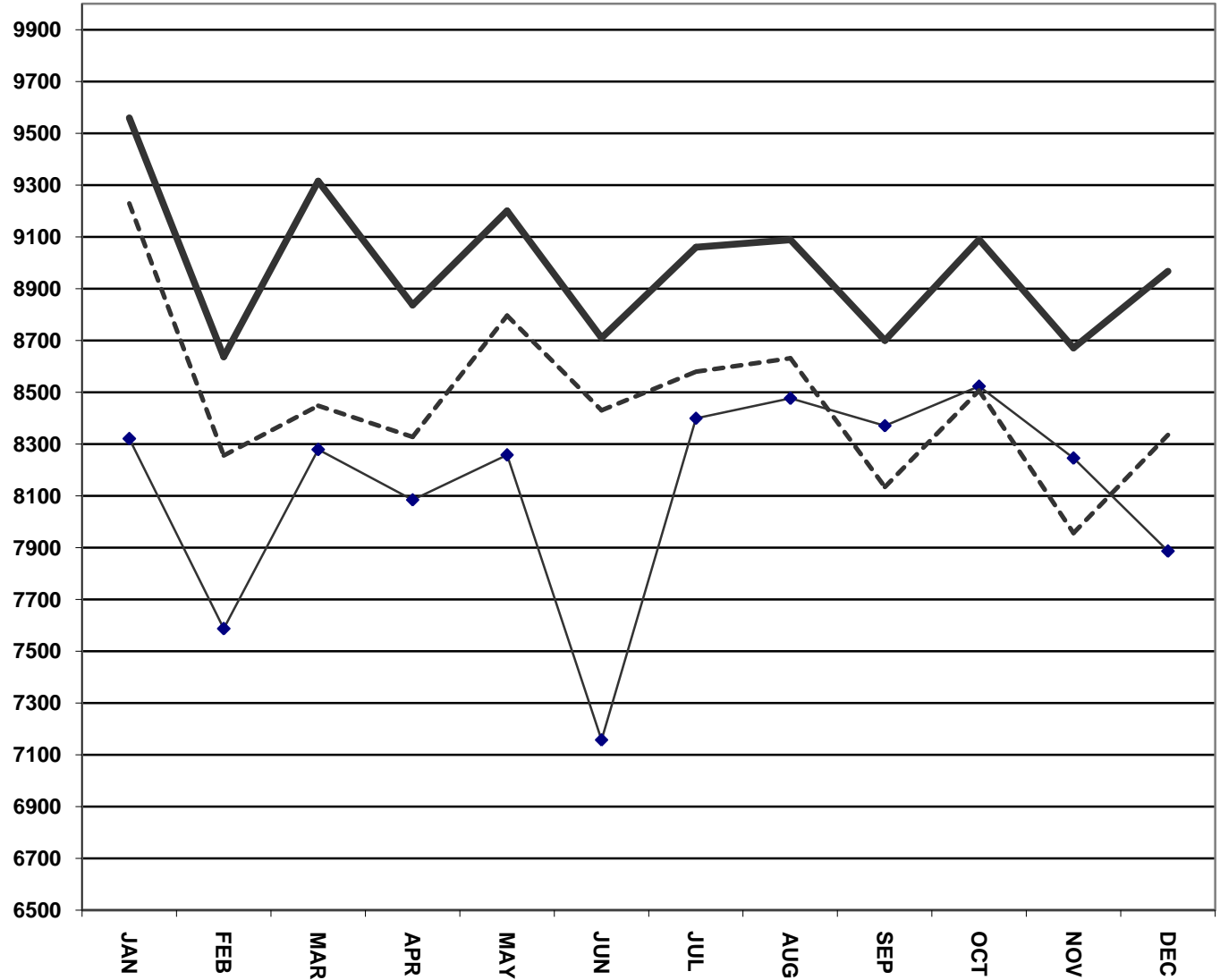
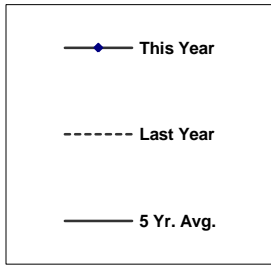

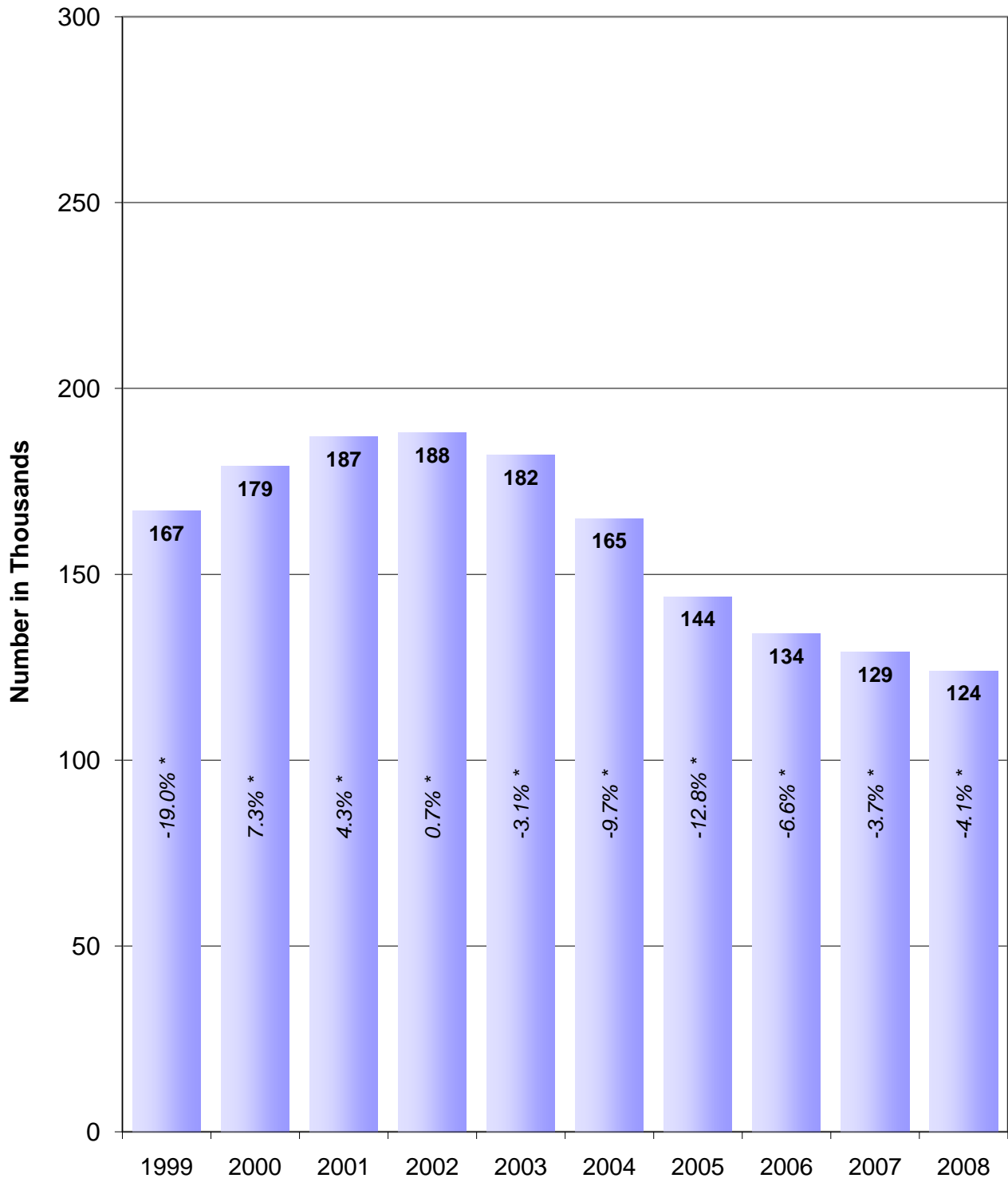

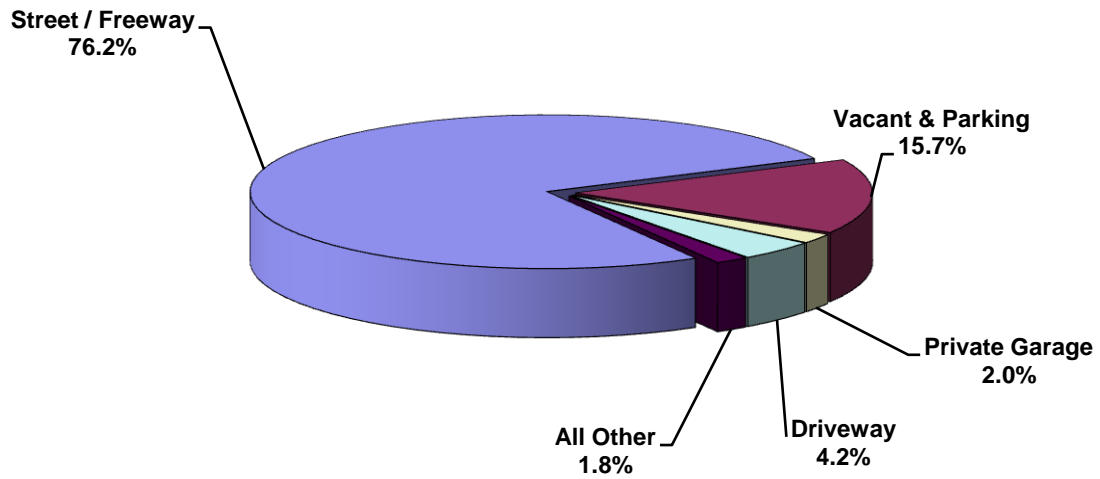

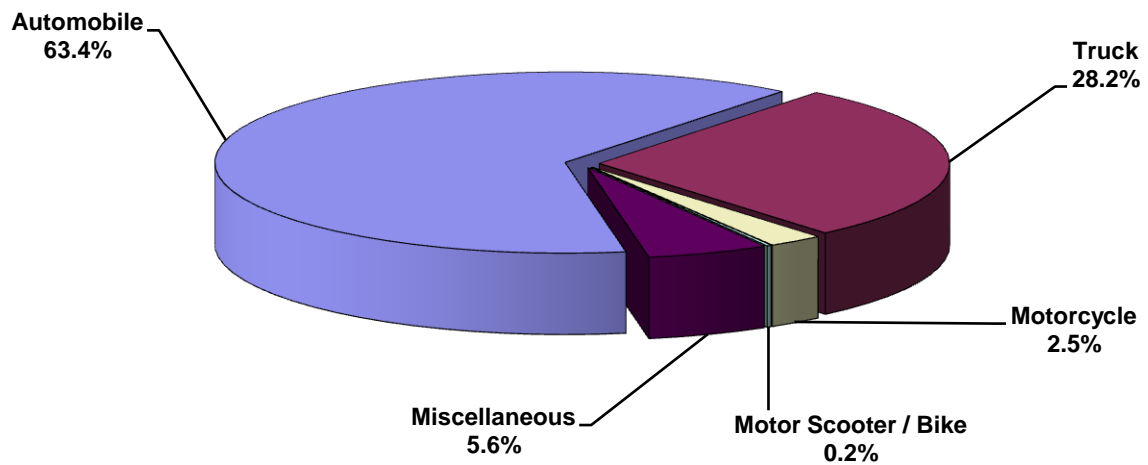

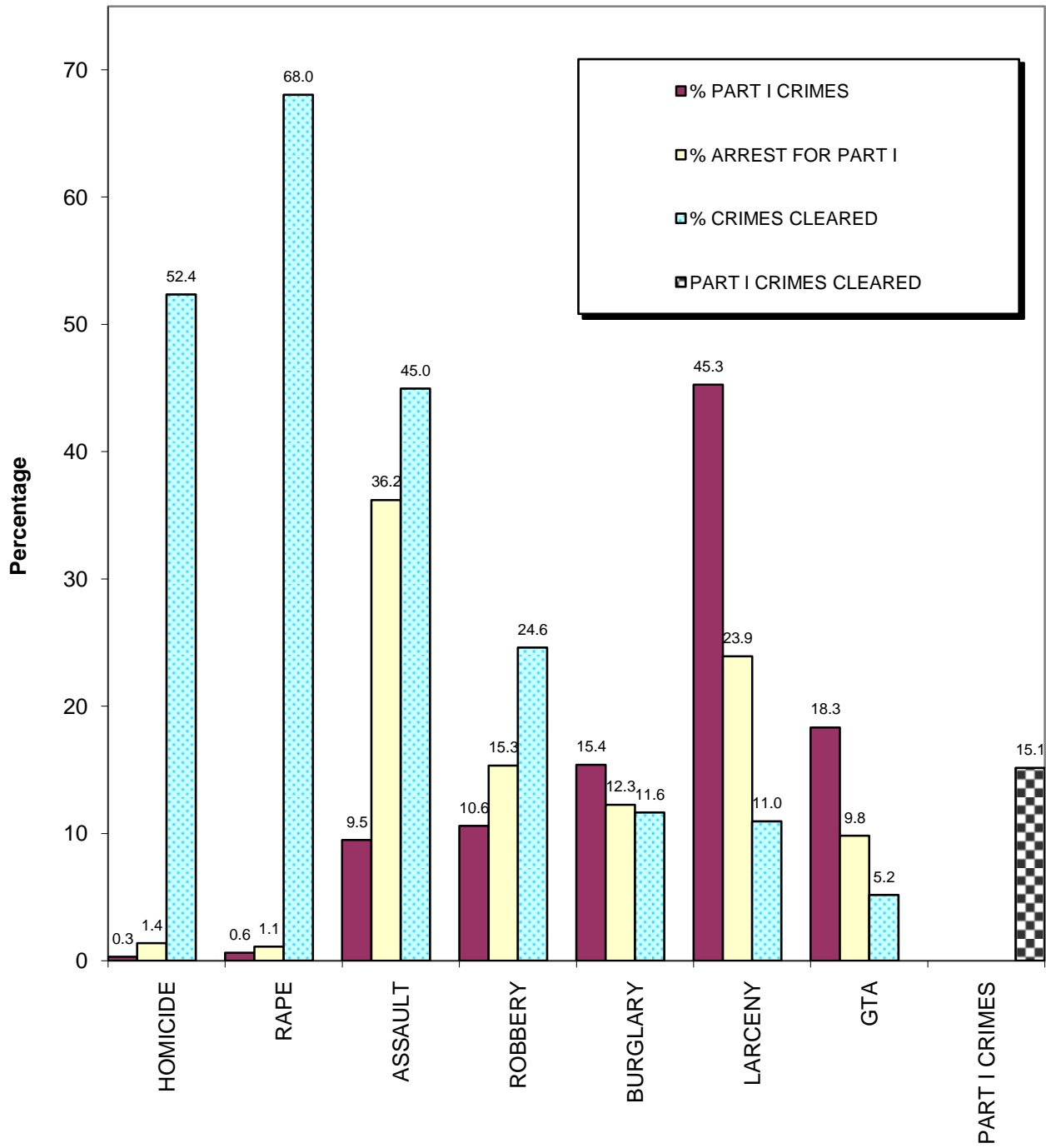
### BY TYPE OF PREMISES WHERE THEFT OCCURRED



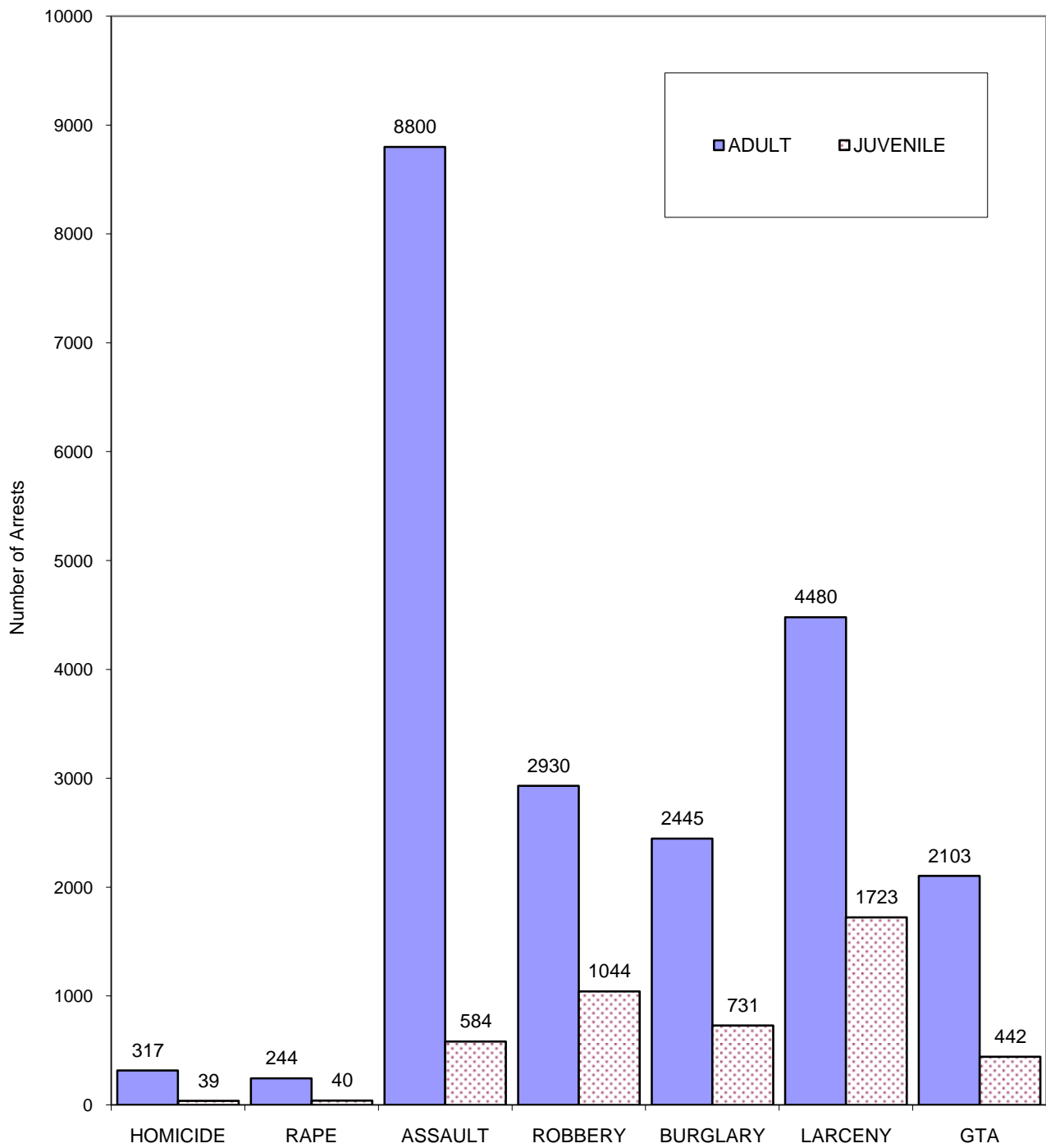
